1	 <p style="text-align: center;">KASINDE FRANK Age: 13 years Class: Senior one</p>	<p>Frank is an orphan who stays with his maternal uncle and is a sicklier. The guardian has challenges in acquiring school fees, school uniform and scholastic materials for this vulnerable child at the same time cater for his constant huge medical bills. The Child's sleeping conditions are poor; he uses torn, dirty bedsheets sheets to cover himself. The guardian is a peasant farmer and cannot afford to cater for his education and basic needs.</p> <p style="color: green;">Patenschaft</p>
2	 <p style="text-align: center;">NALUNJOGI SHAMIM Age: 11 years Class: Primary 6</p>	<p>Shamim is an orphan whose father died and the mother is HIV positive. The family depends on the widow who is administered on Anti-retroviral therapy from Kitovu mobile. The child has not attended school this term due to failure to pay school fees and acquire other school necessities.</p>
3	 <p style="text-align: center;">NAKATO SUZAN Age: 7 years Class: Primary 2</p>	<p>Susan is a total orphan and stays with her elderly grandparents. She has a heart problem and often gets joint pains. She has challenges of getting school fees since the grandparents have no source of income. The family lives in a grass thatched house and the roof of the house is leaking and takes one meal a day.</p> <p style="color: green;">Patenschaft</p>




4	 <p>NAGGAYI DESILANTA Age: 10 years Class: Primary 5</p>	<p>She is a total orphan who lost both parents and stays with her grandmother who is 70 years old. The grandmother is weak she can't sustain the child's school fees, inadequate scholastic materials and doesn't have a school uniform and shoes. The home has hard ships in getting food.</p> <p>Patenschaft</p>
5	 <p>DDUMBA AUGUSTINE Age: 6 years Class: primary one</p>	<p>The child is an orphan who stays with her mother. Ronald's mother is 43 years old and HIV positive The family comprises of six children and mother cannot afford to pay school fees and scholastic materials for all children. He lives in a semi-permanent house with worst sleeping conditions.</p> <p>Patenschaft</p>
6	 <p>LUSWAATA Z Aid Age: 8 years Class: Primary 3</p>	<p>He is a total orphan, who stays with her sister in-law who is 28 years old. Child doesn't attend school regularly due to lack of school fees, school uniform and insufficient scholastic materials. The family practices crop cultivation on a small scale land and doesn't have any other source of income thus making it hard to cater for the whole family.</p>

7	 <p>KYAMBADDE EMMANUEL Age: 10 years Class: Primary 5</p>	<p>Emmanuel is a total orphan whose parents died due to HIV/AIDS. He doesn't attend school regularly due to lack of school fees and insufficient scholastic materials. The family has five other vulnerable children making it hard for them to provide Emmanuel with all basic school requirements. The family practices subsistence farming on a leased plot of land. Income from sale of agricultural produce is very minimal to sustain the family.</p>
8	 <p>SSEBUUMA ROBERT Age: 10 years Class: Primary 4</p>	<p>Robert is a total orphan staying with an elderly grandmother. His parents died of HIV/AIDS. He does casual work (digging and fetching water) every evening to get money for school fees because his grandmother does not have any source of income. He has insufficient scholastic materials and no school uniform.</p>
9	 <p>NAKAWEEESI ZAINAH Age: 7 years Class: Primary 2</p>	<p>Zainah is a total orphan and stays with her grandmother who is 72 years old and bed ridden. The child has no school fees, school uniform and sufficient scholastic materials. She sleeps on a papyrus mat and covers herself with torn bed sheets. The family house is not well ventilated which puts members at risk of acquiring diseases.</p> <p>Patenschaft</p>




10	 <p>KATUMBA JOHN Age: 6 years Class: Primary one</p>	<p>John is an orphan and stays with his mother who is HIV positive. The child's body hygiene is poor and is suffering from ring worms. He doesn't attend school regularly due to lack of school fees and insufficient scholastic materials. John's mother is a casual laborer and the family only gets food when she is paid wages.</p> <p>Patenschaft</p>
11	 <p>NABILUMBI JOAN Age: 10yrs Class Primary 5 & NAMAYANJA MILLY Age: 6yrs Class Primary one</p>	<p>Joan and Milly are total orphans and stay with an elderly grandmother who has no income apart from being supported by community well-wishers. They don't attend school regularly due to lack of school fees and insufficient scholastic materials. They hardly get what to eat and children do casual work in exchange for food.</p> <p>Patenschaft</p>
12	 <p>SEBWAANA JAMADAH Age: 10 years Class: Primary 5</p>	<p>Jamadah is an orphan at the same time he is sick suffering from hernia. He doesn't attend school regularly due to insufficient tuition fees and scholastic materials. The child has no school uniform and enough clothes. His both parents passed on while still young. He is under the care of an elderly aunt who is not employed apart from practicing zero grazing and subsistence farming with her small income; she cannot afford to pay tuition fees for Jamadah.</p>

13	 <p>NAKIWALA EVERLYNE Age: 7 years Class Primary 2</p>	<p>Eve is a single child from a father who is disabled and is unable to walk firmly, her mother died during labor (maternal death). Eve’s father has no income apart from cultivating. Cultivation is very much subsistence and depends on rain and harvest which are very fragile. Eve’s father has no funds to educate her. She is among the orphans that depend on KWOF for her Education. The young girl still lacks school requirements to have decent learning.</p>
14	 <p>NAJJEMBA NOELINE Age: 10 years Class: Primary 3</p>	<p>Noeline is an HIV positive orphan whose father was a fisherman at Kasensero landing site. The father drowned in a fatal boat accident on lake Victoria while fishing. Her mother is HIV Positive and she is in critical condition, currently she is admitted at Nsumba Health Centre. Noeline will not be able to attend school next academic term due to lack of school fees and other scholastics since the mother is bedridden.</p>
15	 <p>NAKYANJA DOROTHY Age: 8 years Class: Primary 2</p>	<p>Dorothy is a very vulnerable orphan whose father was imprisoned for murder of a relative and is to be in prison for the rest of his life. Dorothy’s mother died while she was still young, she is being taken care of by her grandmother who is elderly and can’t afford to pay her tuition fees and meet other school related expenses. Dorothy is a bright pupil who has good attitude towards education. She always performs well in class. Education sponsorship for this child will enable to achieve her dream career of becoming a Nurse.</p> <p>Patenschaft</p>




16	 <p>MUTEBI ROMINE Age: 6 years Class : Primary one</p>	<p>Romine is a total orphan whose family or relatives can't be traced. He was picked from the streets of Kalisizo town by a police officer who handed him over to the District children probation officer. He was later transferred to KWOF for assistance; Romine stays with one KWOF staff as he attends KWOF primary school. Romine needs education sponsorship and other school requirements to attain quality education.</p>
17	 <p>MUKEBI GABRIEL Age: 10 years Class: Primary 4</p>	<p>Gabriel is the first born among two siblings, the child doesn't live with his parents who divorced due to domestic violence. His mother was a house wife while the father was a long distance truck driver. The wrangles between the two became rampant and unbearable which prompted Gabriel's mother to escape to an unknown location leaving the children with their father, The father also ended up abandoning them in a rented house alone. Up to now the whereabouts of these two parents are unknown. KWOF took the responsibility of linking these children to potential families in the community. However Gabriel still faces challenge such as lack of tuition fees and other school requirements.</p>
18	 <p>MULEMA DORIS Age: 6 years Class: Primary one</p>	<p>Doris is an orphan and homeless child, whose parents and relatives dumped two years ago. He was picked by a motorcyclist on the way who handed him over to Kalongo area local leaders, he was later transferred to KWOF for support, He lives with a teacher at KWOF primary school but Doris has school fees challenges, He needs to get permanent solution to his school fees challenges.</p> <p>Patenschaft</p>

19	 <p>LUBEGA MARVIN Age: 6 years Class: Primary one</p>	<p>Marvin was born HIV positive, both parents died while he was still a baby, he was raised by an aunt, but unfortunately she also passed on recently. He now stays with a distant family relative in Kirumba village who is a peasant farmer. Her income is low and cannot afford to pay for Marvin's tuition fees and other school necessities, given a fact she has other family obligations. The child is bright and eager to learn, His biggest challenge is lack of school fees and school requirements.</p>
20	 <p>WANJI ALEX Age: 12years: Class: Primary Seven</p>	<p>Alex lost the bread winner father in August 2016 and the jobless mother is struggling to keep six children alive. Three elder ones dropped out of school and it is feared that Alex may go the same way if not helped to continue education. Needs fees, food and books.</p> <p>Patenschaft</p>
21	 <p>NASSAKA IMMACULATE Age:11 years Class: Primary 6</p>	<p>Immaculate is the eldest in a family of four siblings, she lost two of her parents, two brothers and her sister all of whom died in a space of two years, in 2014 and 2016. With no close relative, She remains in the home of KWOF director. Support is needed for her education, uniform, fees and food. She enjoys singing and dancing.</p> <p>Patenschaft</p>

22	 <p>BABIRYE CHRISTINE Age: 11 years Class: Primary 6</p>	<p>Christine is a grade 6 student with determination to achieve her life objective of becoming a doctor. She likes singing and her best subject is science. She has one sibling but both are orphans, She stays with a distant aunt who is a single mother and does odd jobs to feed, clothe and accommodate them in a rented slum house. She is very needy for tuition fees, food, uniform and scholastics. She has been studying at KWOF primary school for six months. Other schools could not tolerate her due to lack of so many basic school requirements. She is a very prayerful girl.</p> <p>Patenschaft</p>
23	 <p>NANDAWULA MELISA, Age: 4 years Class: Pre-primary</p>	<p>Melisa is a total orphan whose father perished in a motor road accident along Masaka Mutukula high way. The father had migrated from Rwanda to settled in Kalongo Village for casual laborer work. Melisa is a single child who migrated with the father. Her relatives are unknown. She is under the care of a community Volunteer whose income is unstable and has other family responsibilities to manage and control. The child is in a vulnerable state, she requires education support and basic necessities to make her life better.</p> <p>Patenschaft</p>
24	 <p>MWESEZI VINCENT Age: 12 years Class: Primary 7</p>	<p>Vincent is a total orphan whose sero status is positive. He gets medication from Uganda cares/ Kalisizo hospital. Vincent stays with his elder brother who is a casual laborer with unreliable source of income. It is believed the brother is addicted to drugs such as cocaine and often tortures Vincent at night after smoking marijuana. The child has no adequate beddings, sleeps on a worn out mattress and covers himself with worn out and dirty bed sheets. For the last six years a catholic priest was sponsoring his education until his recent transfer to another parish which is very distant. He is about to finalize primary education this year 2019 but lacks tuition fees and other school requirements for next term to sit final examinations.</p> <p>Patenschaft</p>

He lacks sufficient scholastic materials. The family has a problem of getting food. The child needs proper beddings. He was neglected by his mother at the age of two years. He stays with an uncle who is 57 years old. The family has no pit latrine and a drying rack.</p> <p>Patenschaft</p>
26	 <p align="center">SSEGGAYI MARTIN Age: 14 years Class: Primary 6</p>	<p>Martin is a disabled child, disabled children in the district miss opportunities for education and self-advancement. Martin's parents are subsistence farmers with very limited resources for his education. Martin is polite and eager learn and advance to higher level of education. He lacks tuition fees, school uniform and scholarstic materials.</p>
27	 <p align="center">SSEKYANZI JOSEPH Age: 5 years Class: pre-primary</p>	<p>Joseph's father died due to HIV/AIDS. The child doesn't attend school regularly due to lack of school dues. He has insufficient scholastic materials. The family doesn't know the whereabouts of Joseph's mother. He stays with a family friend who is not willing to pay for Joseph's Tuition because he has a big family to take care of. The family has five other orphans. The Child has torn clothes and insufficient beddings. The family where he stays practices subsistence farming.</p>

28	 <p>NAMUNANA ANNET KIZZA Age: 8 years Class: Primary 3</p>	<p>Annette loves singing and is very prayerful orphaned child, who also has to manage her HIV condition which she acquired at birth. She dreams of becoming a teacher or a preacher and loves English subject. With one sibling sister, Annet accepts to live very close to the school with her jobless grandmother who does odd jobs at her age of 60 years. Help is needed for tuition, food, uniform and books</p>
29	 <p>LWANGA ERICK Age: 10 years Class: Primary four</p>	<p>Erick is a total orphan from Kyengeza village. Erick's academic performance at school is good. He stays with an elderly guardian who is approaching 80 years. The family has difficulties in getting food. The Child has insufficient scholastic materials. The family lives in a semi-permanent house.</p>
